

IOWA VALLEY BICYCLE CLUB MEETING

March 8, 2006

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Kris McKibben.

Minutes of the last meeting were reviewed which showed a price quote increase of \$50 (to \$650) to Brian Juel for driving the semi on RAGBRAI. A motion was made by Bill Bucklin and seconded by Lanny N. to approve the minutes and the changes. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed an income of about \$6000 which was mostly for RAGBRAI. Dana B. made a motion to approve the report. It was seconded by Bill B. Motion carried.

The RAGBRAI tickets are paid for and leaves the club with a checking balance of \$7327.07. We have 52 signed up. There was a discussion about sites in Waukee and Newon. It was noted that departure time on the last day to come home will be at 3:00 p.m.

Marshmallow sponsors are coming in. We have received money from 7-8 sponsors so far totaling about \$300. Registration is on the web site.
